Urinary incontinence



Urinary incontinence is the condition in which a person is unable to hold urine and thus releases it, against his/her will. Bladder weakness may range from small amounts of urine (light incontinence, few drops per day), to a complete loss of bladder control (heavy incontinence).

Who can be affected by Urinary Incontinence?

Urinary incontinence can occur to anyone, but it becomes more common with age (people after 65). Women experience incontinence twice as often as men.

Causes of Urinary Incontinence:

Genetic disorders, surgical operations, injuries to the pelvis and the spine, neurological causes, infections and aging. Incontinence in women can also occur after childbirth or menopause due to hormonal disorders.

Types of Incontinence

There are two main types of incontinence: A. Light incontinence **B. Heavy incontinence**

A. Light incontinence

Occasional urine leaks are usually what patients experience when they cough or sneeze. Also some people experience having an urge to urinate that's so sudden and strong that they don't manage to get to a toilet in time.

Common causes:

Light incontinence can be caused by everyday habits, underlying medical conditions or physical problems (constipation, pregnancy, childbirth, changes with age, menopause, hysterectomy etc). For most people, simple lifestyle changes, use of specialized incontinence products or medical treatment can ease discomfort or stop urinary incontinence.

Mostly occurs to women

B. Heavy incontinence

Usually permanent and pathological. Loss of urine more frequently and in greater guantity, compared to light incontinence.

Common causes:

People with impaired mobility, neurological disorders, atherosclerosis, diabetes, Parkinson disease.



It can occur to both men and women

Incontinence is a common phenomenon, but it is not evident:

1 to 4 women over 18 experience incontinence

1 in 10 men over 40 experience incontinence





Symptoms of urinary incontinence




- Urine leakage when sneezing, coughing, laughing or during exercise.
- Urine leakage on the way to the toilet. •
- Frequent urination to the extent that it impedes working or leisure times.
- Urgent urination or the feeling that "I'm not going to make it to the toilet, I'll wet myself".
- Nocturnal enuresis: the need to visit the toilet twice or more times during the night.
- Enuresis: urine leakage in bed while sleeping. •
- Feeling that the bladder is not fully empty following urination. •
- Reduced urine flow. •
- Having to strain to fully empty the bladder.
- Recurring urinary tract infections.

If you experience any of the aforementioned urinary incontinence or frequent urination symptoms, make sure that you choose incontinence products that are designed to offer you protection from leakage and unpleasant odour and visit a specialist immediately. Urinary incontinence is common and can be successfully treated - especially if diagnosed early - so do not hesitate or postpone taking action.



Don't drink too many diuretic beverages, such as chamomile, tea, coffee, carbonated beverages and alcoholic drinks from the afternoon onwards. Lastly, make sure you get the right incontinence products that will offer you safety, will be friendly to your skin and as discreet as you need them to be so that you can get around freely and confidently. Kegel: The exercises that strengthen the pelvic floor muscles and how they can help you



A sedentary lifestyle, long hours behind the wheel, and ignorance about the importance of exercising this group of muscles result in the exacerbation of conditions such as urinary incontinence. Well-exercised pelvic floor muscles enhance sexual pleasure for both men and women. The term "pelvic floor muscles" refers to all muscles located between the lower surface of the pubic bone and in front of the sacrum (coccyx); in fact, they form a swing which supports the rectum, the urinary bladder and the uterus in women.

Arnold Kegel (1894-1981) was an American gynaecologist who, in 1948, devised exercises that strengthen the pelvic floor and that bear his name, as a non-surgical treatment for pelvic relaxation.



The key to the Kegel exercises' success is to understand exactly which muscles we need to contract and relax. The easiest way to do this is to willingly interrupt urination. Of course, this must be done just a few times, until we have understood the group of muscles to which we refer: willingly interrupting urination may lead to urinary tract infections. That's why the correct way to do Kegel exercises is on an empty bladder.

Kegel exercises

Initially, we should make sure the muscles are contracted for 2-3 seconds. Once we have mastered the technique, we can have a programme of at least 5 sets of 10 repetitions of the contractions.

Kegel exercises can be done sitting or standing, while we are driving, at the office and even during cooking. Lastly, they can also be done during intercourse, when the penis is in the vagina, a technique which will add pleasure and guarantee a stronger orgasm for you and your partner, and, of course, help you with any incontinence issues.

In fact, French doctors do not perform incontinence surgery on women unless they have previously completed 3-6 months of Kegel exercises: they have observed that surgery has better results following a set of exercises, as the tissues have become stronger.

Iasi packages are 100% recyclable. MEGA as a producer participates since 2003 in an Alternative Management System (Hellenic Recovery Recycling Corporation, HERRCO) and contributes financially to the recycling of the packaging.

100% Recyclable 30% recycled material

All Iasi packages contain 30% recycled material. The scrap from production of polyethylene bags (PE) in our factory are collected and recycled and finally reborn as primary raw material (polyethylene granules) then it returns to our supplier, who produces bags contining 30% of this reborn PE. This procedure creates a complete, closed recycling cycle, with absolute control over quality and origin of recycled material. All cartons of Iasi consist of up to 100% recycled material.







MEGA has received the sustainability certificate for the protection of the environment and the promotion of a sustainable supply chain model through its participation in the Pooling system of CHEP, contributing to reducing timber, carbon dioxide emissions and waste emissions.
